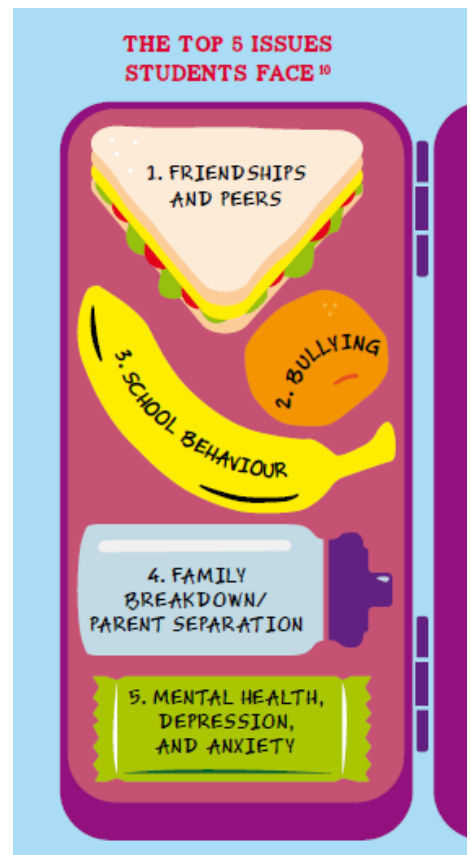
Why I became a Chaplain...
